3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Non-hazardous.

Keep dry. Do not breathe dust when cutting and avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice.

4. FIRST-AID MEASURES

Eye Contact

Material in the eye should be rinsed out using an eye wash bottle or copious quantities of clean water. Seek medical advice.

Inhalation

Where dust is inhaled, remove to fresh air, ensuring the patient's air passages are clear.

5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Personal Precautions: No special measures required

Environmental: High sulphate material subject to regulatory control

Spillage: re-use or contain for disposal

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Store dry. Rotate stocks and avoid damaging the packaging.

8. EXPOSURE CONTROLS / PERSONAL PROTECTION

Avoid breathing the dust when cutting and unnecessary skin contact. Certain individuals may be skin sensitive and barrier cream may be required.

Occupational Exposure Standards (OES) for bulk ingredients.

- Total inhalable dust = 10 mg/m³
8 hour Time Weighted Average
- Respirable dust = 4 mg/m³
8 hour Time Weighted Average

9. PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL PROPERTIES

Inert Powder. Contains soluble sulphate

10. STABILITY AND REACTIVITY

Stable but should be kept dry.

11. TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Non-toxic.

12. ECOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Keep contained and away from waterways

13. DISPOSAL CONSIDERATIONS

Dispose of waste by controlled recycling scheme. Do not place in normal waste stream except in minor amounts.

Non-Hazardous. Keep packs dry and undamaged.
