- **Handling Precautions**
No special precautions. Handle as for standard paper-based materials.

- **Fire hazards**

Unusual hazards

Material is combustible. The material will melt and flaming molten material will spread fire.

Combustion Products

Carbon dioxide, water, hydrogen sulphide, oxides of nitrogen, sulphur dioxide, water and carbon monoxide may be produced on burning. Smoke (solid particulates) will also be produced.

Flash Point

Not applicable to laminate. Flash point of bitumen is 275°C

Extinguisher type

Water (but not water jets if bitumen dripping), carbon dioxide, or foam may be used.

Autoignition Temperature

Paper chars at 200°C and will ignite above this temperature

- **Waste Disposal**

Incineration is possible, but seek specialist advice. May be disposed of by landfill in compliance with Local Authority Regulations and Control of Pollution Act 1974. Material unreactive, cannot be recycled and is not biodegradable.

- **Storage**

Store rolls on sides or ends. Ensure rolls do not fall over and cause injury.


